## All Tuition Is Due The First Of Each Month

### 1-Hour Class Tuition

- 1 class per week \$73/mo\* 4 classes/month

# Studio and Performance Information

**T**he Dance Affair is a performing studio. Our students dance for various organizations throughout the year, with the end goal being our Annual June Performance. This commitment must be made by each student no later than January 4, 2015.

**T**he Annual Show is a commitment to be in class weekly, attend ALL scheduled shows and rehearsals including non-dress rehearsal. Absences during May and June may result in you not being in the show. Please be mindful when planning vacations at this time. Make sure to take this into consideration before committing.

**C**ostume information will be available in early December. Average costume prices are \$55-\$75 per class/routine. Parents are required to purchase costumes on-line at [costume-manager.com](http://costume-manager.com) by no later than January 4, 2015.

### **There are 3 MANDATORY rehearsal dates THAT ALL STUDENTS MUST ATTEND**

- Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup>.
- The week of June 15<sup>th</sup> through June 20<sup>th</sup>.
- The full-dress rehearsal (day of the show), 9:00am Sunday, June 21<sup>st</sup>.

*These rehearsals are not optional. This is part of your show commitment.*

**A**ll families are requested to purchase tickets to the annual show. Ticket sales begin May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

# Dress Code and Dance Shoe Requirements

**Acro Classes:** Black leotard & black bike shorts or black unitard. **NO BAGGY SHIRTS!** Hair must back and away from face. **Shoes:** black acro/gymnastic shoes

**Ballet Classes:** Black leotard, pink tights, ballet shorts or skirt (optional), hair pulled back in bun. **Shoes:** Pink split sole ballet shoes

**Kiddie Combo/ TBJ Classes:** Any style/color leotard & tights. For boys: fitted white or black t-shirt with black shorts or dance pants.

\*\*Shoe requirement for all KK and TBJ students\*\*  
Stretch pink ballet shoes and black buckle taps only available for sale in the dance affair office or online at [Costumemanager.com](http://Costumemanager.com).

## **Dress Code for classes below:**

Black leotard, black bike shorts or black dance pants, tan tights or low white socks. **NO BAGGY SHIRTS!** All hair pulled back and held back away from face.

**Contemporary & Lyrical:** Barefoot or foot undeez

**Hip-Hop Shoes:** Black dance sneakers

**Jazz & Musical Theater Shoes:** Black split sole jazz oxfords

**Tap I, II, III, IV Shoes:** Black tap oxford shoes

# Dance Affair General Policies

**Attendance:** Regular attendance in class is vital to progress

**Tardiness:** Students are expected to arrive & leave on time.

**Observers:** May sit in the lobby only. Please be courteous. No visitors allowed in the classroom area.

**Absences:** Call the studio if you are going to be absent. Make-up lessons are given for illness only.

**Insurance:** The studio does carry liability insurance on the student's; however, in case of an accident, the studio is not responsible for the medical coverage.

**Holidays:** We close for: Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Xmas/ New Years break, President's Day & Memorial Day. See the dance calendar for additional information.

**Make-Up Classes:** Offered for illness only. Absences due to conflicting schedules do not qualify for a make-up class.

**Lost & Found:** The Dance Affair is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Please do not wear or bring valuables to dance class. This includes iPods, phones and other electronics.

**Hair:** All hair shoulder length or longer must be tied back and out of face. Ballet students should wear hair in a bun.

**Parents:** Responsible for picking up students promptly after class is over. Children must not be left to wait in the lobby for any long period.

**Teachers:** Each teacher may add or expand on the policies for his/her class and may remove any student from class for failure to observe the policies.

\*No food, gum or drinks are allowed in the lobby or class area. Water only in closable containers. Students here for multiple hours may eat outside.
